The Patachou Foundation is dedicated to feeding wholesome meals to food-insecure school children in our community, and teaching them to create healthy habits.

## WHAT WE DO

We feed nutritious after-school meals to at-risk and food-insecure children in our community while increasing their awareness, connection and excitement about the whole food they are eating.

## HOW IT WORKS

Community volunteers and Patachou staff volunteers prepare, deliver and serve nutritious meals to children at schools and community centers in areas with low food access. At the same time, The Patachou Foundation’s volunteers teach about making positive choices, exploring new tastes, and using manners at the table through our unique, hands-on education program.





# BECAUSE OF YOU

JANUARY 2015

The Patachou Foundation continues serving 250 meals per week to four different schools at The Boner Fitness and Learning Center at the Chase Legacy Building.

JUNE

The Patachou Foundation starts serving 600 meals a week and begins serving at two summer camps.

AUGUST

The first new meal site, IPS 58, was added since our inception.

Mighty Lotus joins The Patachou Foundation to provide yoga and mindfulness activities to the youth we serve.

**FILLING STOMACHS AND FILLING MINDS**

We recognize it takes more than just feeding bodies to change food-insecurity—it takes a holistic approach. The Patachou Foundation has also designed a unique, experience-based education curriculum focused on the joys of the table through nutrition, cooking skills, and meal-time manners.

Field trips are a part of it..... We hosted over 70 campers to Public Greens and Napolese to learn about flavor combinations, sustainability and table etiquette. In partnership with Growing PlacesIndy, Earch Charter Indiana and Patachou chefs, students harvested vegetables, explored the importance of the environment, practiced table manners and made pizza in our wood-fire oven. It was a day filled with fresh food education, laughter and full bellies.

**IMPACT**

Reach 1000 individual students annually.

**PHYSICAL FOOTPRINT**

Develop a dedicated production and teaching kitchen.

**STAFF DEVELOPMENT**

Strategically increase staffing to support growth, developing a staff of leaders dedicated to making authentic change.

**VOLUNTEERS**

Increase volunteer base to 150 volunteers actively engaged each month.

**FUNDRAISING**

Increase fundraising to support a growing impact in the community and diversify funding sources to reach 25% of operating budget from granting organizations.
